3. LEGISLATIVE REPORT (Missy Dean, Director of Governmental Relations)

STATE ISSUES:

A. **INFORMATION:** Support SB 1240 by Sen. Mike Mazzei/Rep. Terry O'Donnell that creates the Public Safety Protection District allowing cities to create a Public Safety District and assess no greater than five (5) mills for the district to fund police, fire and jail operations

B. **INFORMATION:** Support SB 1057 by Sen. Jack Fry/Rep. Kevin Calvey, Firearms/Events. This bill will allow cities to prohibit guns at events if it is on property/building owned or controlled by city, county, state and federal government, a public property sports field or sporting event where an elementary or secondary school, collegiate or professional event is played or an International Olympic Committee, fairgrounds during the Oklahoma and Tulsa State Fair and if there is a contract for the event.

Lee Denney that allows a property owner to file a request for judicial location exception with the county court if the owner objects to a corporation's desire to locate its pipeline, utility line or other transmission line on said property. The bill requires the court to conduct a hearing to determine if an alternative location would be possible.
